

UI review report

Walkthrough, screenshots, usage, remaining issues, and suggested improvements.

Captured 2026-09-11. Browser console: no application errors after favicon data-URI (catalog static server still 404s a missing favicon.ico until the next full site deploy).

What was fixed in this pass

- CS / sales / accounting / access-staff restyled to the portal indigo system. Dollars and names, not cents forms.
- Fleet replica and service actions collapsed to one overflow menu (flips up near the viewport edge). Power is status. Disabled machines are grey.
- Add-machine is two rows: identity path is wide plus a filename picker; roles are chips. Header: operator LAN · binds 0.0.0.0:3850.
- Docs tab is cards. Trace hop grid wraps. Skip link and focus rings on staff and console.
- Simulator indigo; orange only on Inject faults.
- Portal API key masked. Invoice and statement empty states are cards, not table rows. Staff typeahead uses customer names. STAFF_AUTH=1 uses verae-staff-session.
- Admin customers: list vs edit drawer. Invoice empty state.
- Catalog body font is system-ui. Swagger /docs stays stock with an integrator banner only.
- CS and access-staff share verae-staff-ui review.html.
- Staff cookies accept STAFF_COOKIE_DOMAIN for a reverse-proxy host.

How to use each surface

Operator: open :3850, Fleet for replicas, Trace to inject a Zap step, Docs for PDFs. Staff: CS :3011 credit in USD; Sales :3012 quote; Accounting :3013 export; Staff plane :3025 after authz. Customers: /portal. Ops: /admin. Lab: simulator :3847.

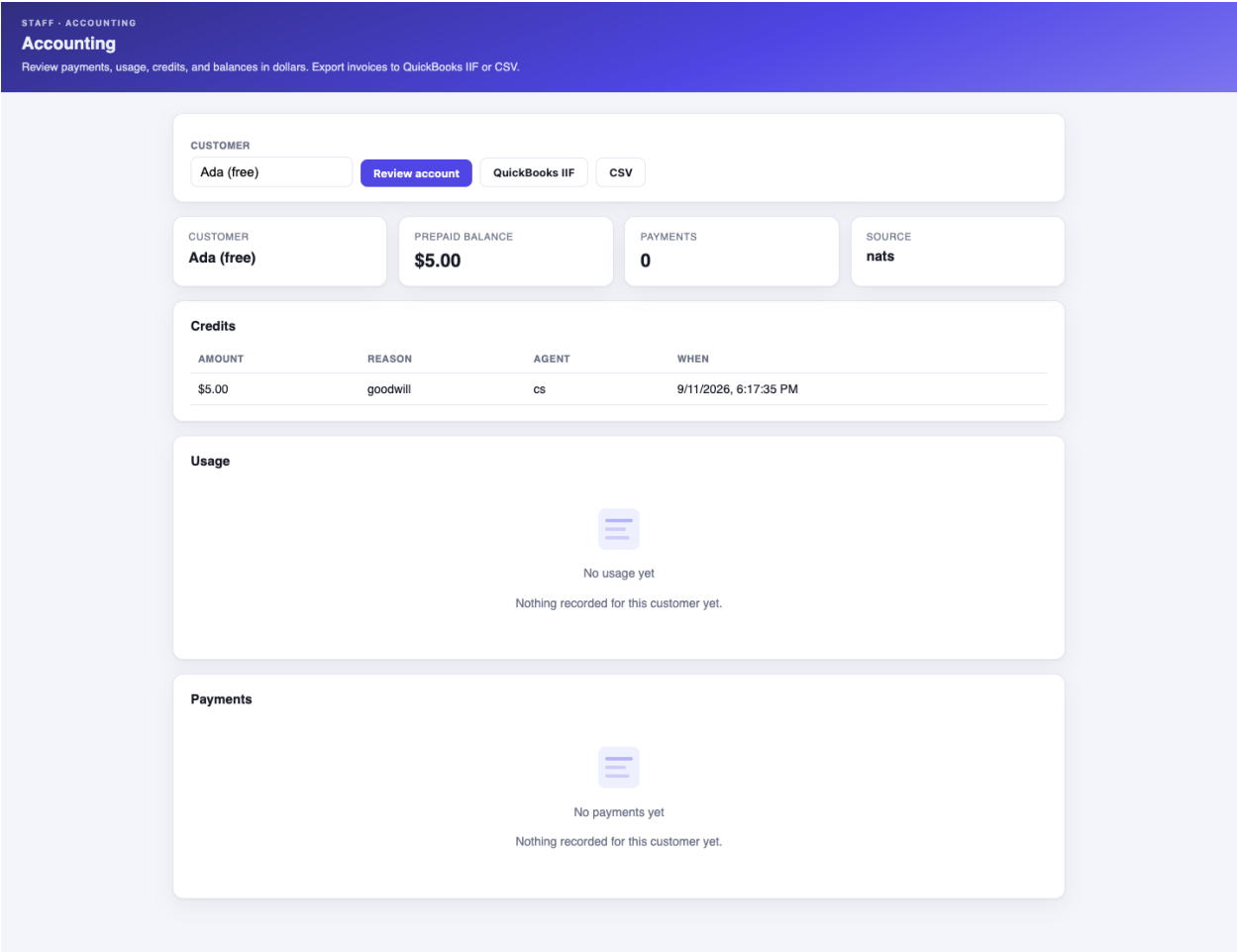

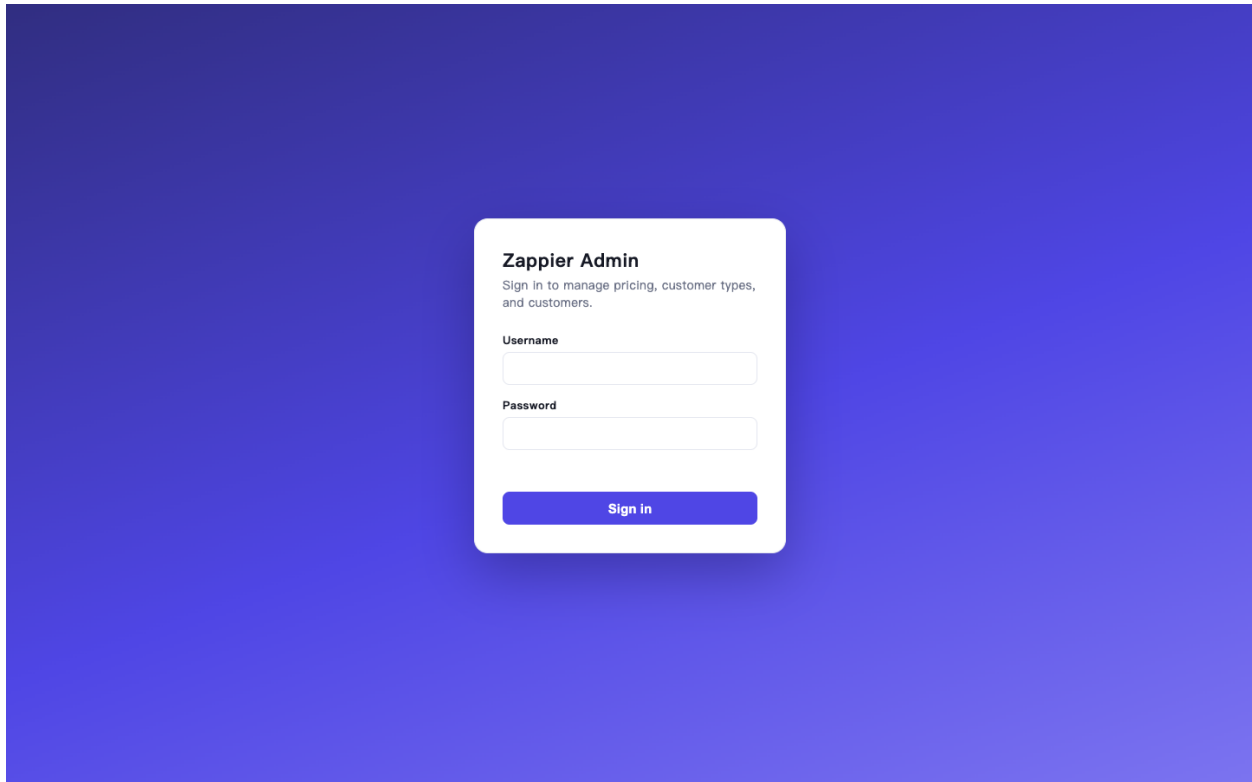

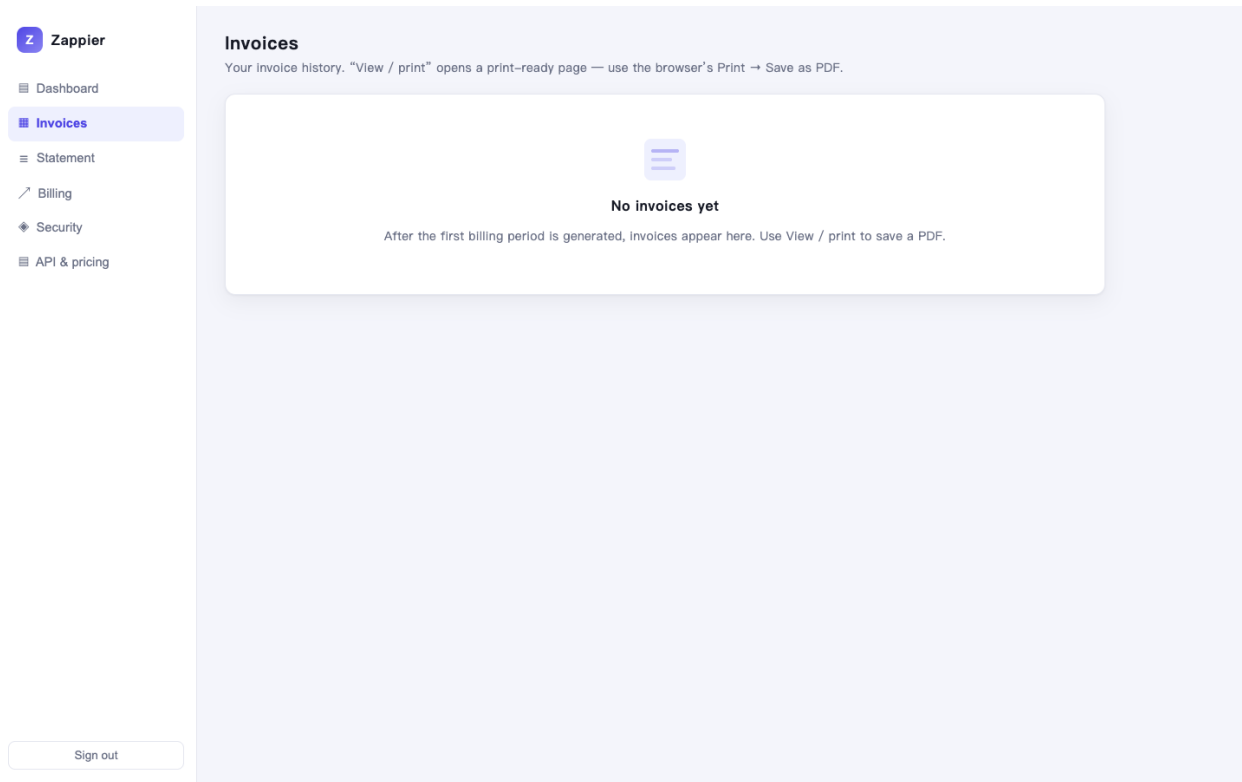
